
Phonics Morning

Our Topic

Planet Protectors—

How does our planet sustain us?

This half term we will be learning about:

⇒ Seasonal changes

⇒ Comparing our local area with a contrasting place

⇒ Creating colour in Art.

Maths

This half term we will be:

Counting to 100 and above, starting at any number.

Adding (+) and subtracting (-)

Multiplying (x) and dividing (÷)

You could help your child at home by:

Counting in 2s, 5's and 10s.

Practicing Number Bond challenges.

Sharing objects around the house into groups of 2, 5 and 10

English

This half term we will be:

Creating information leaflets around recycling.

Diaries linked to our work on seasons in science.

You could help your child at home by:

Reading daily to help build up a bank of language.

Practise sounding out words for spelling.

Show examples of leaflets you may get through the post.

Keep a simple diary at home.

Science

This half term we will:

Observe changes across the 4 seasons.

Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

You could help your child at home by:

Observing and discussing the weather daily.

Sharing experiences of places you have visited and the weather you saw.

Art and Design

This half term we will:

Learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers.

Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.

You could help your child at home by:

Practicing mixing colours and discussing what happens when we mix colours.

Visit art galleries around Bradford and discuss the art work.

Geography

This half term we will:

Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans.

You could help your child at home by:

Looking at maps and atlases.

Discussing how the weather in the UK has changed since your Grandparents were younger.

<u>P.E</u>

This half term we will:

Orienteering and Adventurous Games.

Describe position, directions and movements, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

You could help your child at home by:

Practicing directions of left and right as well as North, East, South and West.

Look at moving whole and half turns.

Make up games based on moving in different directions.
