Diversity

This half term we will be learning about:

Maths

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Find the total number of objects when they are grouped into 2, 5 or 10.
- ⇒ Recognise odd and even numbers.
- ⇒ Look at multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and
- ⇒ corresponding division facts.
- ⇒ Solve money problems involving multiplication and division of money.

You could help your child at home by:

Counting in 2, 3, 5 and 10s.

Practising writing numbers from 0-100 in words and numerals.

English

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Writing diaries, ilnked to the Great Fire of London
- ⇒ Writing Non-Chronological reports and newspaper articles, using the information which we've learnt about the Great Fire
- ⇒ Learning to extend our sentences by adding extra information using conjunctions.

You could help your child at home by:

- ⇒ Reading with your child every day (particularly non-fiction texts).
- ⇒ Practise using conjunctions to extend sentences.

History

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Sequence the events of the fire.
- Recognise that the Great Fire happened over 300 years ago.
- ⇒ Identify how different building materials were used and houses were spaced differently.
- ⇒ Look at how houses and streets are safer today.

You could help your child at home by:

-Discussing similarities and differences between

London in 1666 and London now.

-Talk about the materials used to build modern houses.

Computing

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Discuss E-Safety and how we can stay safe when we are online.
- Record, locate and review sounds using IT resources.
- ⇒ Capture, edit and evaluate images and videos.
- ⇒ Create and evaluate simple animations

You could help your child at home by:

- ⇒ Discussing E-safety and the importance of not sharing personal information online.
- Accessing Purple-Mash applications at home. Allow the children to evaluate their work and discuss possible ways to improve.

Science

This half term we will:

- -Identify and compare the uses of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard.
- -Identify and sort materials according to their properties and uses.
- -Plan and conduct a fair test, to explain the method used and the results achieved.

You could help your child at home by:

- Looking at different objects and discussing the material used.

Religious Education

This half term we will:

- Identify the purpose of celebrations and how people celebrate special days.
- Research special days celebrated in Christianity, Islam and Hinduism.
- ⇒ Discuss how these celebrations are similar or different and recognise the key traditions to identify these celebrations.

You could help your child at home by:

- -Talking about how your family celebrates special events or days (religious or non-religious).
- -Discuss what types of food are eaten, clothes are worn, decorations etc.
- Read books linked to celebrations and special days.
