English

This half term we will be:

Instruction writing—How to make a Victoria Sponge Cake

Stories set in the past.

You could help your child at home by:

Reading daily to help build up a bank of language.

Practice sounding out words for spelling.

Encourage your child to think of new and exciting characters.

Look at examples of recipes.

History

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Look at how school has changed since the Victorian times.
 - ⇒ Learn about the life of Victorian children.
 - ⇒ Compare past and present.

You could help your child at home by:

Talking about what yours or Grandparents memories of school are.

What did you learn at school?

Art and Design

This half term we will:

You could help your child at home by:

Visit art galleries around Bradford and discuss the art work.
