Maths

This half term we will be covering:

- ⇒ Application of operations in context—word problems.
- ⇒ Algebra and formula.
- ⇒ Measures, money and time.
- ⇒ Fractions, decimals and percentages.
- ⇒ Data handling

You could help your child at home by ensuring that they know their x tables up to 12×12 .

English

This half term we will be covering:

- ⇒ Writing a Greek Myth.
- ⇒ Writing a biography about Genghis Khan
- ⇒ Persuasive writing.

You could help your child at home by practising the year 5 and 6 spellings at the back of the home school diary. Asking them to write stories at home.

Practising spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Reading

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Read a range of poems.
- ⇒ Our class novel will be Percy Jackson and Lightning Thief.
- ⇒ Wider reading about Light, the eye and the Ancient Greeks.

You could help your child at home by ensuring that they take part in the Raving Reader challenge by recording their reading every day in the home school diary. Asking your child about their reading book. Visits to the library and discussing articles that they have read.

<u>Science</u>

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Learning about the eye and how we see.
- ⇒ Learning about rays of light.
- ⇒ Learning about the spectrum of light.

You could help your child by researching light at home.

Art

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Creating sculptures of Greek mythical creatures.
- ⇒ Using Damien Hirst as our artist inspiration.
- ⇒ Using a range of equipment and tools to create our pieces.

You could help your child by looking at different types of sculpture and other famous artists.
