W/b 12.10.2020	<p>Repeating Patterns</p> <p>We are looking at repeating patterns this week.</p> <p>Can you find some objects in your home and make a pattern that repeats at least three times?</p> <p>Parents you may need to model this first and ask the children to continue the pattern then make up their own.</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Re-read the text 'There is no Dragon in this Story' using YouTube link (book alive)</p> <p>Label the characters in the picture with their initial sound e.g. b for bear.</p> 	<p>Weekly Graphemes - h b f l</p> <p>Revisit all previously taught graphemes/ tricky word/ decodable words</p> <p>Recognition of new graphemes</p> <p>Formation practise:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>h b f l</i></p> <p>Blending new graphemes within words e.g. hot, hat, bat, bag, fan, fed, lit, lad</p>	<p>Traditional Tales</p> <p>Can you draw a story map of one of your favourite traditional tales?</p> <p>Draw pictures for the key events in the story in order.</p> <p>Extension: Label characters with initial sounds.</p>
