Maths

- Play times-tables games with your child.
- Spend time completing tasks on Mathletics together

English

This half term we will be:

- Writing character descriptions.
- Writing diaries (Focusing on 1st person writing)
- Writing different types of sentences
- Editing our independent work.

You could help your child at home by:

Reading with your child every day (particularly comic style books) Practise using adjectives to describe characters or objects.

History

This half term we will:

- Find out about the typical life of a Victorian child
- Investigate how life changed for children
- Make Victorian toys
- Share our ideas for a better future

You could help your child at home by:

- Completing project homework
- Explore local museums and talk about how we know something is from the past.

Geography

This half term we will be:

- Investigating local fieldwork and maps of our local area. We will be identifying the human and physical features.
- Devising maps which show the route we travel to school.

You could help your child at home by:

 Discussing the human and physical features in Bradford/Canterbury with your child. How are they different? How are they similar?
