Maths

This half term we will be:

Learning about division using sharing into equal groups

You could help your child at home by:

Finding different 2D and 3D shapes around the home Finding halves of amounts, such as halving a group of grapes Dividing shapes into halves, investigating quarters on shapes

This half term we will be:

Writing a detailed character description

Writing a set of instructions

You could help your child at home by:

Reading daily to help build up a bank of language.

Practising sounding out words for spelling.

Encouraging your child to use the Oxford Reading Tree website to read stories

Science

This half term we will:

Learning about the human body and looking at the different parts of the body.

You could help your child at home by:
