## Maths

This halfterm we will be covering:

- ⇒ Application of operations in context—word problems.
- $\Rightarrow$  Angles.
- ⇒ Measures, moneyand time.
- ⇒ Data handling.
- ⇒ Geometry, shape and coordinates.
- $\Rightarrow$  Ratio and proportion.

You could help your child at home by applying their concept of measures e.g when cooking or travelling in a car.

## English

This half term we will be covering:

You could help your child at home by ensuring that they take part in the Raving Reader challenge by recording their reading every day in the home school diary.. You could expose your children to newspapers and encourage them to read the wider news with you.

#### Scienc e

## This half term we will:

- Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines
- Understand that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources, hits an object and reflects into our eyes
- Use the idea that light travels in straightlines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the
  objects that cast them

You could help your child by researching light at home.

## PSHE—Citizenship

## This half term we will be:

- · To consider my local community and recognise some institutions that support it.
- To know about the institutions that support communities locally and nationally.
