Maths

This half term we will be covering:

- ⇒ Angles
- ⇒ Geometry
- ⇒ Data handling

English

This half term we will be reading the story of 'Boy 87' and will be covering:

- ⇒ Writing a diary entry
- ⇒ Writing a short narrative

You could help your child at home by practising the year 5 and 6

spellings at the back of the home school diary. Asking them to write stories at home.

Art

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Using Romero Britto as inspiration.
- ⇒ Researching and designing our own carnival masks.
- ⇒ Evaluating our art work.

You could help your child at home by showing them different art pieces and discussing colour, texture and inspiration.

Science

This half term we will :

- ⇒ Understand and associate the brightness of a lamp with voltage of cells used in the circuit
- ⇒ Use recognised symbols when creating a circuit .
- ⇒ Compare different circuits and give reasons for different variations e.g. brightness of bulb

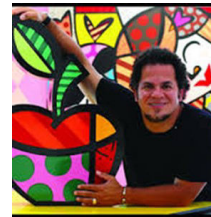
You could help your child by researching information about different electrical equipment
