Dates:

<u>Times:</u>

When we return in September, the following start and end times will apply for <u>ALL</u> pupils **8.40am – 3.00pm**.

Uniform:

- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
- White plain polo shirt
- Grey shalwar kameez
- Grey skirt/ pinafore dress/ cloth trousers
- Plain navy or black hijab (head scarf)
- Plain, low black shoes or plain black trainers NO boots or trainers with logos

PE Uniform:

- Navy blue or black shorts/jogging bottoms
- White t shirt
- Black trainers/black PE pumps
- Navy blue or black tracksuit for outside games

On the specified day of PE for your child, they should come to school in their school PE kit. This should be school PE kits only.

ParentPay:

All payments for lunch, milk, toast and trips **MUST** be paid via ParentPay – **No cash will be taken in school**. If you require assistance with this, please speak to somebody in the office.

The deadline for milk and toast is Friday 10th September 2021.

Toast = \pounds 5 per half term.

Milk = $\pounds 5.50$ per half term.
