Fly Tipping

This is an ongoing problem for the school and many parents and families have shared their concern about this taking place near and on the school grounds. We need your support in reporting this to Bradford Council if you see it happening.

Fly tipping is a crime. Penalties include:

- fixed penalty notice of £400
- an unlimited fine and up to 5 years in prison
- vehicles used to commit offences can also be seized and crushed

Did you know? Householders can be fined up to £5,000 and end up with a criminal record if they ask someone else to remove their rubbish and it is found to be fly tipped. Don't use unlicensed waste carriers.
