Creative Home Learning (Project)

Write a short biography about a historically significant person who lived in the past.

Research and create a timeline of Neil Armstrong's education and training, beginning and ending with the Moon landing.

Creative Curriculum—Movers and Shakers

Our driver project is **Movers and Shakers**. This project teaches children about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance. They will learn about Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong, Emmeline Pankhurst and Rosa Parks. Children will think carefully about their impact of their actions.



Maths

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Finding out about digits and their place value
- ⇒ Using less than & greater than symbols < >
- ⇒ Telling the time in 5 minute intervals

You could help your child at home by:

- ⇒ Ask your child to write numbers as words
- ⇒ Making amounts with 10ps and 1ps
- ⇒ Refer to the clock in your house, taking about the current time.

English

This half term we will be:

- ⇒ Writing 4 kinds of sentence—question, statement, command and exclamation
- ⇒ Forming letters correctly and knowing the letter names and sounds for each.

You could help your child at home by:

- ⇒ Write sentences together—“your turn, my turn”
- ⇒ Give your child a sentence to write from memory.
- ⇒ Using adjectives to describe something in the house.

Maestro companion project 1

Science: Human Survival

This half term we will:

Learn about the basic needs of humans for survival, including the importance of exercise, nutrition and good hygiene. We will learn how human offspring change overtime into adulthood.

Maestro companion project 2

Art: Mix It

This half term we will:

We will learn about basic colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. We will explore primary and secondary colours and how artist use colour in their art-work. We will learn how to talk about art and reflect on our own art work. We will use question stems and a phrase book to help us.

Maestro companion project 3

Geography: Let's Explore the World

This half term we will:

Learn how to use an atlas and read world maps to discover new information. We will use compass points and prior knowledge to describe locations in the UK. We will find out more about the four countries in the UK and collect information about them. We will collect data about people use a local human feature in Bradford too!

PHSE: What Keeps Me Healthy?

This half term we will:

Know about the important of physical activity, sleep and rest. We will find out about how germs are spread, how we can prevent them spreading and people who help us stay healthy and well. We will also find out more about eating well and making good food choices.
