Creative Curriculum—Driver Project

Children will build on learning from Spring 1 by having the opportunity to learn about the work of the RNLI, what happened to the SS Rohilla and about the coastal town of Whitby, including how Captain Cook is linked to the town. Maths

In maths, children will:

- Count on in 2, 3, 5 and 10
- Estimate on a number line
- Partition numbers into different ways e.g. $34 = 30+4$, $20+14$, $10+24$
- Tackle problems in the context of money
- Recall all number bonds within 20

English

In English, children will:

- Read the story, 'The Secret of Black Rock.' We will create a setting description and continue to use expanded noun phrases and a range of conjunctions.
- Formulate and writing a range of questions.
- Write a character recount from a character's point of view of events in the story.

Science

This half term we will:

This half term the children in Year 2 will learning about the uses of materials and how materials' properties make them suitable for specific purposes. They will also begin to explore how materials can be changed. Year 2 will begin to look at describing properties of natural and human-made materials and where they are found in the environment.

Geography

This half term we will:

- Learn about the human and physical features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom
- Exploring the coastal town of Whitby in Yorkshire.
- Identifying past and present features of Whitby
- Researching the life significant individuals who have a link to the coastal town of Whitby including Captain James Cook.
