School Streets Initiative

We would like to inform you that our school will soon be implementing the School Streets initiative via Bradford Council. A School Street involves restricting vehicle access on specific streets during term time, particularly at the beginning and end of the school day.

The primary objectives of this initiative are to:

- Reduce congestion around the school premises
- Prevent hazardous driving, parking, and turning in areas with high pedestrian traffic
- Mitigate air and noise pollution caused by vehicle engines
- Create a safer, more tranquil, and healthier environment for our children
- Encourage alternative modes of transportation such as walking, cycling, wheeling, and scooting to school.
- We appreciate your cooperation and support in ensuring the success of this initiative for the benefit of our entire school community.

This has been in consultation and the legal order will **go into force from 22nd April 2024**. The school will be implementing this from Monday 10th June 2024. Local residents will be receiving a letter from Bradford Council in the coming weeks informing you and providing information of how local residents are able to apply for a permit.
