History-WWII

This half term we will:

- Gain and deploy a historically grounded understanding of abstract terms such as 'empire', 'civilisation', 'parliament' and 'peasantry'
- Study an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066.
- Articulate the significance of a historical person, event, discovery or invention in British history.

Science-Evolution and Inheritance

This half term we will:

- This project teaches children how living things on Earth have changed over time
- We will analyse how fossils provide evidence for this.
- We will learn how characteristics are passed from parents to their offspring
- Learn how variation in offspring can affect their survival, with changes (adaptations) possibly leading to the evolution of a species

<u>Art-</u>Bees, Beetles and Butterflies

This half term we will:

- This project teaches children about sketchbooks, observational drawing, mixed media collage and Pop Art.
- They will consolidate their learning to make a final piece of artwork inspired by bees, beetles or butterflies.
- Children will compare different artists work and identify similarities and differences
