Creative Curriculum-Movers and Shakers

about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.

Music

English

This half term we will be:

Reading the story, of Rosa Parks. We will be writing a letter in the role of Rosa Parks herself, to the government!

You could help your child at home by:

- Write sentences together— "my turn, your turn"
- Encourage your child to write sentences to include conjunctions (and, but, or, because, when, if)
- Create a poster with adjectives to describe toys

Maestro companion project I - Art Still Life

This half term we will:

This project teaches children about the work of
